

PREFACE

The Directorate of Youth Services & Sports J&K has a mandate to promote Physical Education and Sports amongst the school going children both Boys & Girls in the age groups of U/14, U/17 and U/19 studying from class 6th to class 12th. The department has 45 sports disciplines both individual and team games on its canvas and every year the new games and sports are being added to this number upon creation of infrastructure needed for the purpose.

The Youth Services & Sports department has its presence in Middle, High and Higher Secondary Schools across the Union Territory through its trained and professional human resource viz. Physical Education Lecturers, Physical Education Masters, Physical Education Teachers and Rehabar-i -Khel's. Their role and responsibility is to identify, nurture, coach and train the student players of all the three age groups both boys and girls in sports disciplines of their choices at school level. Besides, the players are made acquainted with the latest rules, skills and techniques of the game to inculcate in them the spirit of competitions. Sports competitions at various levels viz. Intramurals, Inter-School (Zone level), Inter- Zone (District level) and Inter- District and (UT level) are conducted to bring forward the best talent to compete at National level competitions.

Apart from conducting the domestic level competitions, the department deploys the teams for National Level competitions being organized by the School Games Federation of India across the Country. The department also hosts 3-4 such National level events in Jammu & Kashmir. The students/ players are provided all facilities like food, transport, equipment, uniforms and other required logistic support to give them an opportunity to excel and prove their mettle in sports at National and International Levels. The department has available a well-trained human resource that harness the capabilities of the students for future endeavours. The department also prepare students to take part in all extracurricular activities viz; Seminars, Debates, Disaster Management Programmes, Drug De-Addiction campaigns, Fit India Movement, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Plogging Runs, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Plantation Drive, Back to Village Programmes, My Town My Pride programme and celebration of Red Letter Days as well.

The Department is also on the forefront to actively participate in all the programmes of the Govt at District/ Divisional/ UT levels in co-ordination with District/ Divisional / UT Administration. The Youth Services & Sports has also been entrusted to conduct sports competitions at Panchayat level for Youth beyond age group of 19 Years to 35 Years and above. As a part of Youth engagement, YSS Cup has been introduced for many games under this initiative to attract Youth



at Panchayat, Block and District levels. The Department has also accomplished a prestigious tournament entrusted to it under Mission Youth Programme for Youth under the banner of LG's Rolling Trophy.

RESPONSIBILITY OF OFFICERS AT DIFFERENT LEVELS:

INTRAMURALS:

It will be the responsibility of the Principal/Headmaster of the Institution/School to monitor that intramural activities are conducted by Physical Education Staff posted in the school and every student is involved in one or the other sports activity. The Physical Education staff posted in the school shall maintain the record of intramural activity and submit the same to ZPEO concerned duly attested by the Head of the Institution for online registration within a weeks' time.

ZONAL PHYSICAL EDUCATION OFFICERs:

It will be the responsibility of Zonal Physical Education Officer to draw a calendar of activities for inter school (Zone level) activities in consultation with District Youth Services and Sports Officer concerned and ensure that every school under his/her jurisdiction both Private and Government participate in the Inter School (Zonal Level) competitions.

ZPEOs shall also ensure that a copy of the calendar is made available to every Head of the Institution in the zone. The inter School (Zone Level) records shall be maintained by the Zonal Officers. Participation certificates at Inter-School Zone level shall be issued to the student players under the seal and signature of ZPEO concerned and DYSSO.

DISTRICT YOUTH SERVICES AND SPORTS OFFICERs:

It will be the responsibility of the District Youth Services and Sports Officer to draw a calendar of activities for Inter-Zone (District level) and inter School District Level competitions in consultation with concerned Joint Directors. It shall be mandatory for ZPEOs to participate in every game at Inter-zone (District Level). The DYSSOs shall allow those students to participate at this level who have played at Inter School (Zonal Level) and are registered on the official website.

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The DYSSOs shall ensure that all the teams are ready for inter District (UT/Divisional level) competitions by the dates prescribed by the Directorate. The Merit/Participation certificates shall be issued under joint signatures of ZPEO concerned and (Host) District Youth Services & Sports Officer concerned. The DYSSOs shall maintain the records of the competitions at this stage.

JOINT DIRECTORS:

It is the responsibility of Joint Directors to conduct inter District (UT Level) competitions for the Pools in their respective Divisions through District Youth Services & Sports Officers as per the availability of infrastructure and choice expressed by DYSSO in the districts. The Joint Directors shall ensure that all the districts participate in every game for which the competition is held. The Selection Panel / Technical Committees shall be appointed by the Joint Directors for smooth conduct of these competitions as per the professional efficiency list duly submitted by the DYSSOs. The Merit/Participation certificates shall be issued to the players under the joint signatures of Host District Officer and Joint Director concerned. The records of the competitions shall be maintained by the concerned Joint Directors.

DIRECTORATE:

The Directorate shall organize coaching camps for all the selected players of both the pools and get the best talent identified through a series of selection process / trials for further participation in National School Games being conducted under the aegis of School Games Federation of India (SGFI) prior to the dates fixed by the SGFI/ other competitions. Directorate has to plan all requirements in advance.

ADVENTURE SPORTS

Basic / Intermediate / Advance Skiing Courses (both Boys and Girls) shall be conducted at UT level during the winter 2023 -24

DYSSO Baramulla, DYSSO Budgam, DYSSO Bandipora, DYSSO Anantnag and DYSSO Ganderbal, under the overall supervision of Joint Director Kashmir shall be In-charge of Ski courses at Gulmarg, Yousmarg, Gurez, Pahalgam and Sonamarg respectively.



Besides participation in ski courses, other winter fun games be also made a part of winter sports.

Trekking shall be conducted by every Zone at least for 100 Boys and Girls each. The best 5 trekkers from each Zone separately for Boys and Girls shall be identified by concerned DYSSOs who shall be sent for advance trekking at UT level.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

The annual calendar of activities discussed and approved by the committee is appended herewith for implementation. The calendar shall be subject to:-

- 1. The detailed report of Intramural competitions duly signed by the Concerned Principal / Headmaster and ZPEO shall submit to DYSSOs for on-line registration at District level till such time zones are equipped with necessary facilities.
- 2. It is mandatory for every DYSSO to register the participants on the official website from intra-mural level as per the instructions.
- 3. The calendar shall be prepared by the District Youth Services & Sports officers concerned in such a way that the teams for participation at Inter District (UT) level are ready by the dates prescribed in the calendar of activities 2023-24 appended herewith. They shall submit a copy of calendars to the Directorate by 25th of March 2023 through Divisional Offices/Joint Directors. Care must be taken by DYSSOs that dates fixed for activities do not coincide with the examination dates issued by JKBOSE or other authority of Education Department.
- 4. The DYSSO concerned shall ensure that all the schools Govt./Private participate in the Departmental activities at Zonal level / District Level. The teacher whose Schools/Institution will not participate in the departmental activities his/her increment shall be kept withheld. The Zonal Officers shall be held responsible for non-participation of schools in sports competitions and shall regularly monitor participation of students at every level.
- 5. No player or team shall be allowed to participate at Inter- District UT level directly unless he/she has not taken part in the competitions at all lower levels.
- 6. The venue In-charge/Convenor shall ensure proper dress code (As per the requirement of the game) of the student player and officials.



- Deputation of Teachers for any Associations / Federations during the competition days shall not be allowed.
- 8. All the field officers/convenors shall get the activities duly highlighted through Print / Electronic /Social Media for creating an interest and attraction amongst the students.
- 9. The DYSSOs /ZPEOs shall also organize social awareness programmes like Plantation drives, Drug de-addiction, Disaster Management Programmes, Plogging Run (s), Water Conservation Drive (s) for the benefit of students as well as community. Further, they shall also communicate the participation details to the Division / Directorate in time. Furthermore, they shall also coordinate with the administration in organising the other programmes as and when asked for.
- 10. The ZPEOs / DYSSOs shall ensure raising of Band and March Past troops in every zone particularly at Hr. Secondary / High school Level and conduct the competitions along with other games. The ZPEOs / DYSSOs shall assess the performance of Band Masters on EPM strictly on raising of Band Troops & March Past Troops in the district.
- 11. The District Youth Services and Sports Officer shall prepare a list of contingent In-charges preferably game officials.
- 12. The female staff member shall always accompany a female contingent and under no circumstances a male member be made a part of female contingent.
- The inter district UT Level competition shall be conducted in all district throughout the Union Territory as per the availability of infrastructure in the district and choice expressed by the District Youth Services and Sports Officer.
 The inter-district UT Level Competitions shall be organized in pools separately for 10 districts of Kashmir in Kashmir Province
- and separately for 10 districts of Jammu Province under the supervision and monitoring of concerned Joint Directors.

 15. The selected teams at provincial level shall be provided coaching and training at a place to be fixed by the Directorate and a
- team for participation at National School Games shall be selected out of these players through a proper selection process.
- 16. Boarding, lodging, food, transport, equipment and refreshment shall be provided strictly as envisaged.
- 17. No data of the activities shall be accepted at Divisional/Directorate level if same is not in parity with the data uploaded on the web portal.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. Selection Committees for Inter District (UT Level) competitions shall be framed by the concerned Joint Directors.
- 2. No official from the Host district shall be the part of selection process for UT Level Competition. Further the selection of teams should be as per the prescribed selection/norms/ format / criteria.
- 3. No Selection List will be disclosed at the venues. Officials associated with academies (being run in violation of SRO 164 dated; 27-03-1980 Circulated by the GAD vide circular No 08-CAD of 2015) shall not be the part of any selection process at any level.
- 4. For every age group / gender wise selection panels shall be different.
- 5. The Physical Education staff members whose wards are taking part in the sports competition shall not at any stage be a part of the selection process.
- 6. There will be two selection panels (Gender Wise) of three members each for every age group.

Review Meetings

- 1. The District Youth Services & Sports Officers shall conduct the monthly meetings on every 2nd of the month to review the progress of calendar of activities and submit the information to Joint Directors concerned by 3rd of the every month.
- 2. The Joint Directors shall conduct the monthly meetings on 3rd of every month to review the progress of Calendar of activities and submit the information to the Directorate by 5th of every month for onward submission to Administrative Department.
- 3. The Directorate shall conduct quarterly the review meetings to monitor the progress of the calendar.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUTH HOSTELS:

- No player without Contingent In- charge shall be allowed to enter the hostel premises.
 - No Student Player shall be allowed to move out of the hostel withoutContingent In -charge.
- 3. No team shall be allowed to move out for competition without escort teacher.

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- The Hostel staff both male /female shall remain round the clock present in the hostel during competition days. 4.
- During competitions /stay of teams Warden should keep adequate medical aid available in the hostel 5.
- Warden should maintain a register for entry and exit of inmates of the hostel at the reception throughout the year for all kinds 6. of the activities and it will be the responsibility of the warden to cross-check the attendance of the players / contingent incharge on daily basis (morning & evening).
- Equipment for National Level Coaching Camps shall be kept available at the stores of the Youth Hostels. 7.
- Warden shall ensure cleanliness of rooms, washrooms and hostel premises on regular basis. 8.

off places or panchayats shall be provided boarding and lodging on the days of competition as per norms. The winning team shall represent the district at UT Level tournament. Playing Kit shall also be made available at venue

4. **UT Level: Inter District (UT Level)** competition shall be held either at Srinagar or Jammu. The participants shall be given refreshment @ Rs100/ and actual local transport charges from District to venue and vice versa. The participating teams shall be provided boarding and lodging on the days of competition as per norms. The winning teams shall be awarded trophies, medals and cash prizes to be decided separately. Playing Kit shall also be made available at venue.

(B) LG Trophy

1. During the session 2022, the Government launched a prestigious programme in sports with lucrative enticements through Mission Youth J&K which was organized by this department under the banner of LG's Rolling Trophy (Cricket), 42802 players participated in this trophy. The final match was played between Jammu and Anantnag on 9th of March 2023 at M.A Stadium Jammu which was witnessed by more than 12000 people. The initiative has been hailed by one and all. The programme may be an annual feature and more games are likely to be included under this programme. The department shall extend all support to Mission Youth in conducting such programmes in future.





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
