



History of the Department of Youth Services & Sports

The Department of Youth Services & Sports came into being in the year 1973 and prior to that it was a part of the Education Department. Mr Nazir Ahmad Khan was the first Director General of the Department. The Department has over a period of time brought on its canvass a wide spectrum of activities like organizing Domestic & National Level Competitions in various games and sports for School Children, conducting Physical Education activities like Mass Physical Display in various schools, promoting adventure sports, engaging school children in extracurricular activities like dance, drama, painting, quiz and debates, Youth and Cultural Festivals and promoting Scouts & Guides activities across the State and outside. The Department caters to the personality development aspect of school children through Physical Education. The activities are being supervised by zonal officers at Zonal Level, District Officers at District Level, Joint Directors at provincial level and Director General at state level. The Department also renders the services in case of any eventuality like Disasters of any kind and in pandemic like corona etc, besides encouraging the youth in various social activities in the State. The Department also runs a College of Physical Education at Ganderbal which was established in 1976 to offer two Courses, viz, 02 years B. P. Ed (Bachelor of Physical Education) course and 02 year M.P.Ed (Master of Physical Education) course in a regular study mode. Intake capacity for B.P. Ed is 80 & for M.P.Ed 25 candidates purely selected on entrance basis & on a varied test batteries of Physical fitness. The college offered only 02 C.P.Ed courses, one in 1984 & second in 1989. The Department was reorganized in 2008 and the posts of Zonal Physical Education Officers, Lecturers and Masters were created. Recently Rehbri-khel Teachers and Grounds-men were also appointed.

A Brief Description About Khel Gaon Nagrota Jammu

he Department is thankful to Mr K Vijay Kumar, Advisor to Hon'ble Governor J&K and Mr Sanjiv Verma, Divisional Commissioner Jammu for realizing the need of the Department for conduct of various sports activities and competitions in a multipurpose sports facility in Jammu. For the purpose, the Department was provided a piece of land at Khel Gaon Nagrota Jammu for its development into a multipurpose sports playfield. This was possible because of the efforts of Shri Farooq Khan Advisor to Hon. Lt. Governor and Mr Sarmad Hafiz, Secretary to Govt. Department of Youth Services and sports Jammu & Kashmir.

The Department in a very short span of time converted this barren piece of land into different playfields where sports activities could be conducted throughout the year. The Department was able to host 65th National School Games in the discipline of Volleyball U-17 years and Kho-Kho-U-19 years for boys on this facility.

As a new initiative, a patch of land was reserved for each team, who visited the State to participate in National Level Competitions to plant over 15 hundred plants at Khel Gaon, Nagrota. The field has a large capacity and at the Inaugural Ceremonies, thousands of people witnessed these mega events. Mr. Farooq Khan, IPS (Retd) Advisor to the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor in presence of Financial Commissioner Finance Sh. A. K. Mehta, (IAS) and Sh. Sarmad Hafeez, (IAS) Secretary Youth Services and Sports laid the foundation stone at Khel Gaon Nagrota Jammu. The department has initiated the process for the construction of a high quality Indoor Stadium, Synthetic Football and Volleyball grounds, Swimming Pool, shooting range and State of the Art Infrastructure which will create an environment conducive for higher learning in the field of games and sports.

We look forward to provide an ideal ambience to the athletes of Jammu & Kashmir and hope that it will prove a nurturing ground for all sports persons of J&K to compete at National and International Levels.

The courses started from 19-12-2019 with the strength of 60 students per batch (Boys & Girls). Financial Commissioner Dr. Arun Kumar Mehta accompanied by Mr. Sarmad Hafeez, Secretary to Govt. Youth Services and Sports Department and Dr. Saleem-ur-Rehman, Director General Youth Services and Sports J&K along with his crew had a good time at the slope interacting with the trainees of 11 Districts of J&K. Both are very good skiers also. Dr. A. K Mehta also took the stock of the arrangements efficiently made by the department of Youth Services and Sports, besides enjoying the moonlit night Skiing commingled with the flood lights. Director General Dr. Saleem-ur-Rehman while briefing about these courses said that the department trained 400 Boys and Girls across J&K so far and over a 100 local boys were also trained side by side. 60 Boys & Girls from College of Physical Education Ganderbal received training in basic, intermediate and advanced courses this winter. 03 training courses, exclusively for girls were also conducted, Director General YS & Sports said. He also reiterated that the last Ski Course of 60 students (Boys and Girls) will culminate the Winter Sports at Gulmarg in the month of March if snow withstands the heat of the sun
